

2. Standard Uniform for Cadets

Male	Female
Head dress: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Level with forehead with the brim about 2.5cm directly above the left eyebrow • Cap badge must be directly above left eye • Beret should be folded to the right 	
Hair: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trimmed short at the side and back • Should not touch the collar • Hair must not be dyed 	Hair: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plait up hair and clip it up with the figure-of-eight clip if hair is long • Hair net must be worn at all times • Hair must not be dyed
Shirt: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Badges must be straight at all times using the pockets as the guideline • Collar of the shirt must be well ironed and stand • No thread must be seen 	Blouse: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Badges and name tag must be in-line with the first button • Badges must be straight at all times • Collars must be well pressed • No thread must be seen
Trousers: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All seams must be well pressed • Seat of trousers must be reasonably loose and not too tight • Leg of trousers must cover the ankles • No thread must be seen 	Skirt: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be reasonably loose and not too tight • Maximum of 2 inches above kneecap • No thread must be seen
Belt: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Belt loops must be darkened • Two fingers away from the belt loop • Should be polished and worn comfortably; free of dust 	Belt: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two fingers away from the belt loop • Should be wiped and worn comfortably; free of dust
Socks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Black • No logo socks are allowed 	Socks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Black • No logo socks are allowed • Socks should not be folded down
Boots: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Polished and free of dust 	

Personal Appearance

Cadets must be smart in turn out and bearing. Smart turn out simply means:

- wearing polished boots
- smart bearing means looking smart in the way you project your image to others
